seed	The small part of a flowering plant that grows into a new plant.	Parts of a Plant
bulb	A plant bud that begins to grow underground. Tulips and crocuses grow from bulbs.	Flower Stem
plant	One of a large group of living things that use sunlight to make their own food.	The Dia
light	The form of energy that makes it possible for the eye to see. The sun produces light.	Roots D
water	A clear liquid that has no taste or odour. Water takes the form of rain, rivers, oceans, and lakes and is a requirement for most forms of life.	Carlos and the second s
temperature	The degree of heat or cold of an object or an environment.	Germination cycle
leaf	One of the usually green, flat parts of a plant or tree that grows from the stem or branch.	
stem	The main part of a plant that grows up from the ground and supports the branches, leaves, flowers, or fruits that may grow from it.	
root	The part of a plant that usually grows underground. Roots take up water and nutrients, and hold the plant in the soil.	
flower	The part of a plant that has petals and that makes fruit or seeds; blossom. Flowers often have a pleasant smell.	
germination	To start or cause to start growth; sprout. The seed will germinate if it gets enough water and sunlight.	
soil	The top layer of the earth's surface.
