The children will be participating in lots of reading related events throughout the day, based around the following books or themes:

Early Reedley – ‘Zog’, ‘Room on the Broom’ and ‘What the Ladybird Heard’ by Julia Donaldson
‘Supertato’ by Paul Linnet and Sue Hendra
‘Oi Frog’ by by Kes Gray

Lower Reedley – ‘The Day the Crayons Quit’ by Drew Daywalt

Middle Reedley – Harry Potter books by J. K. Rowling

Upper Reedley – ‘Alice in Wonderland’ by Lewis Carroll

Due to the success of last year’s book nooks, we have set a ‘Creative Challenge’ for your child(ren) to complete as part of their half term homework. This is to design and make a ‘book in a jar’ that shows their favourite scene or section from a book (fiction or non-fiction). I have included some pictures to help you.
